Dress Code

This dress code has been established to help our students focus on academics, coordinate their apparel, and present themselves modestly.

Professional Dress Days:

Boys: Dress shirt/pants with belt, tie (optional), dress shoes, & matching dress socks.

Girls: Dress or skirt/dress pants w/blouse & dress shoes/sandals.

**If this is not observed on the day designated, the student will be asked to wear professional dress the following school day.

Daily Dress Code:

Shirt:

Button down collared shirt, blouse, henley, polo, sweater, or fleece. *(No screen printing on shirts.)*

No sleeveless or cap sleeves on shirts. Shirts tucked when appropriate.

Pants, slacks or shorts:

While standing with hands at side, shorts must be the length of one's longest finger.

While standing with hands at side, students wearing leggings must wear a shirt the length of one's longest finger.

Skirts/Dresses:

Skirt/jumper/dress length to the top of the knee or longer; slits no higher than top of the knee may be worn with nylons, tights, or bare legs. It is recommended that K-6 students wear shorts under skirt/jumper/dress.

All skirts, jumpers, dresses must not be shorter than the student's hand width (measured across the palm), above the knee and must be worn with opaque tights (not sheer/sheen).

General Dress Code Details: (Apply for Daily Dress Code & Professional Dress Days.)

No logos.

Neatness, cleanliness, and modesty observed at all times.

Clothing must be free of visible repairs.

No cleavage or mid-section exposed.

Excessively worn, faded, soiled, or over (loose fitting) / undersized (tight) clothing is not permissible.

No blue jeans, sweatpants, wind pants, yoga pants, stretch pants, sweatshirts, or t-shirts.

No hats worn in school.

No sandals, backless or open toe shoes for outside play. Shoes must be in good condition.

Students must have tennis shoes and socks at school at all times.

Sunglasses, non-prescription glasses, jackets, or other outer coats are not to be worn in the classroom or halls during the school day. (These items should be kept in the student's locker.)

Jewelry: Students are required to remove jewelry when participating in PE or Athletics. SPCA is not responsible for 'lost' or broken items.

Boys: No piercings are permitted.

Girls: Two earrings per earlobe may be worn. No plugs, spacers, or gages. Piercing is not permitted in any other area.

Hair & Grooming:

Hair must be kept styled out of eyes. Hair must be kept clean and be well taken care of.

Hair and accessories should not draw undue attention to the student.

Tattoos, real or simulated, are not permissible.

Fingernail polish well groomed.

Natural skin tone make up may be worn as desired to cover blemishes.

Boys: Facial hair must be clean shaven or neatly trimmed. No fingernail polish.

7th -12th grade student option: natural color highlights are acceptable.

7th -12th grade girl's option: make-up may be applied modestly: no dark lipstick or eye liner/shadow.

Students wearing make-up deemed unacceptable will be asked to remove it.

Special Dress Days

Each month, the SPCA Student Council selects 'special dress days'.

These special dress days will have a unique theme, such as Christian t-shirt day, favorite sports team day, or career day.

Please note the following important information regarding special dress days:

All attire must be modest, fit appropriately, and be in good condition.

General dress code details apply, see previous page.

Students may choose to wear SPCA apparel and jeans on Friday Theme days in place of the theme designated by Student Council.

Senior Dress Code

This dress code has been established to promote modesty while allowing seniors greater flexibility. Our intention is to allow seniors to make positive choices to represent themselves through their apparel.

Professional Dress Days, Hair & Grooming, Skirt/Shorts/Dress Length, & General Dress Code Details

(Neatness, cleanliness, and modesty to be observed at all times) **continue to apply to seniors.** No cleavage or mid-section exposed. Excessively worn, faded, soiled, or over (loose fitting) / undersized (tight) clothing is not permissible.

No logos.

Seniors are permitted to wear jeans and SPCA apparel. Other dress code expectations apply.

Athletics and Physical Education Dress Code

Students in grades K-4 will wear regular school apparel to PE.

Students in grades 5-12 are required to change into clothes for PE. The SPCA PE dress code is as follows:

**Please note PE apparel must be logo free, with the exception of SPCA.

Deodorant, SPCA T-shirt, SPCA Sweatshirt, Sweatpants (for cold weather over shorts)

SPCA Gym Shorts ****Boys need to wear compression shorts under.**

Non-skid Athletic Shoes & Athletic Socks (Cleats optional for Flag Football & Soccer)

Volleyball: Knee Pads & Volleyball

Athletic Supporter Cup (Boys)

Mouth Guard (Flag Football)

If students or parents are unsure whether apparel is acceptable, remember:

1. When in doubt...don't wear it. If you think an article of clothing isn't appropriate, do not wear it.
2. Ask questions if you need help determining if something is inappropriate or if you don't understand the dress code or any other policy.

*Administrative decisions concerning whether or not a student meets dress code requirements shall not be disputed.

*Five or more dress code slips, (including PE dress code) will result in a student detention; each occurrence thereafter will result in an additional detention.
